Tenacious is a modern iteration from Rutgers University, that possesses Mesotrione resistance, improved disease resistance, and mowability not typically associated with hard fescues. **Tenacious** has excellent seeding vigor and summer persistence that is required for the hard fescue category. **Tenacious** has excellent performance when mowed at fairway/tee height along with great traffic tolerance for fine fescues. **Tenacious** will still perform when fertility is reduced. This variety has excellent resistance to leaf spot, red thread and summer patch. **Tenacious** blends well with other fine fescues. It also mixes well with wildflowers and other cool season grasses like Kentucky bluegrass, tall fescue and perennial ryegrass.

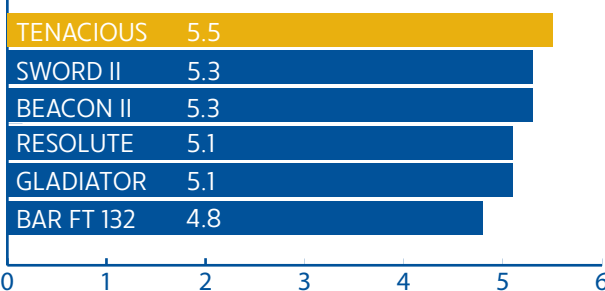

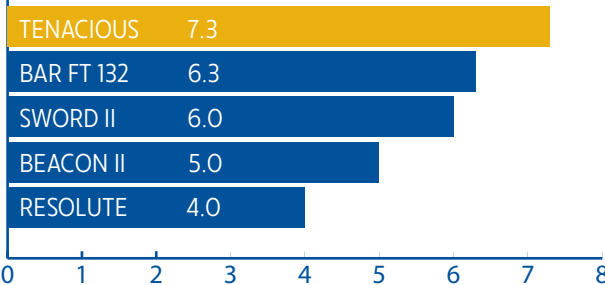
