



Jersey is a well balanced selection from Rutgers University. It possesses early spring green up, good summer performance, excellent seedling vigor and aggressive growing habit. **Jersey** has excellent seed handling characteristics with moderate seed size and seed count average of 1.2 million per pound. This cultivar has exhibited good resistance to powdery mildew and stem rust in turf trials and commercial production fields. In commercial production fields better mesotrione resistance is observed. Seed production is consistent and availability should be consistent year to year.




